

- Time for exploration (depends on site)
- Lunch

#### IT'S MORE THAN JUST A FIELD TRIP!

- Pairing of classes from schools that combine in middle school
- Buddy-up of students from different schools
- Pre/post-visit classroom activities
- Take-home book to read with families
- Grants for buddy-up trips to other DT sites
- Come-back pass for entire family
- Teacher professional development workshop Continuous improvement of the program through professional evaluation



#### **KDT! PROGRAM OUTPUTS**

- 3,700 student trips per year
- 25,000 student trips since 2005
- 100% participation by Ithaca, T'burg schools
- ICSD classes buddy up with another school to promote cultural awareness

#### **SOME KEY IMPACTS**

- Adds hands-on to classroom lessons
- Engages un-engaged students
- Reduces conflict in middle school
- 30% continue learning at home
- 12% use their family come-back pass






Our goal is for every child in Tompkins County to experience *KDT!* 

#### **BUDGET FOR TOMP CO**

- 6,000 student trips @ \$30
- \$180K per year
  - \$80K (Disc Trail)
  - \$40K (Districts)
  - \$60K (NYS BOCES Aid)
- In-kind from school districts
  - Busing
  - Teacher professional development time
