Rural Services	access to services to those living outside of the City of Ithaca within Tompkins County
Resource Equity	access for individuals/families with low to moderate incomes, to programs, resources and opportunities
Human Rights	fundamental rights for all individuals (e.g. employment, housing, non-discrimination, health care)
Advocacy	advocacy and community organizing to influence decisions within economic, governmental and social institutions

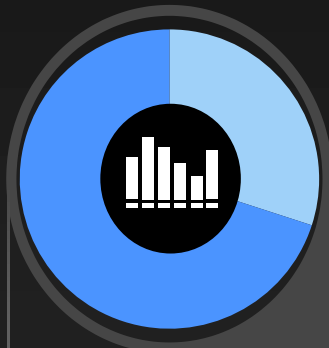
Social Justice Grants Analysis

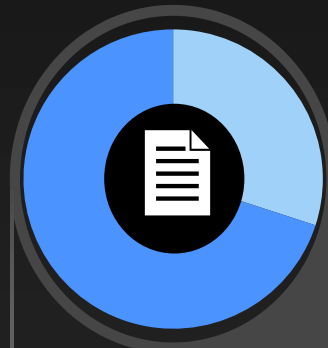

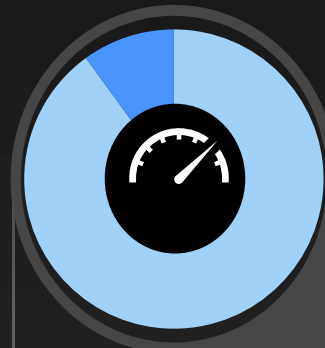
