Asset	Transfer Method	Position relative to Will or Trust
Life Insurance	Beneficiary Designation	Higher Priority
Automobile	Title	Higher Priority
Real Estate	Deed	Higher Priority
IRA	Beneficiary Designation	Higher Priority
Brokerage Account	Account Registration and/or TOD (Transfer on Death)	Higher Priority
401(k), 403(b) etc.	Beneficiary Designation	Higher Priority
DAF Balance	Named Successor Charitable Beneficiary	Higher Priority
LLC Interest	Governing Document	Higher Priority

Also, transferable assets with POD (Payable on Death) or TOD (Transferable on Death) designation: **Checking and Savings Accounts, Security Deposits, Savings Bonds and Certificates of Deposit, all hold higher priority than a will with POD or TOD**.
