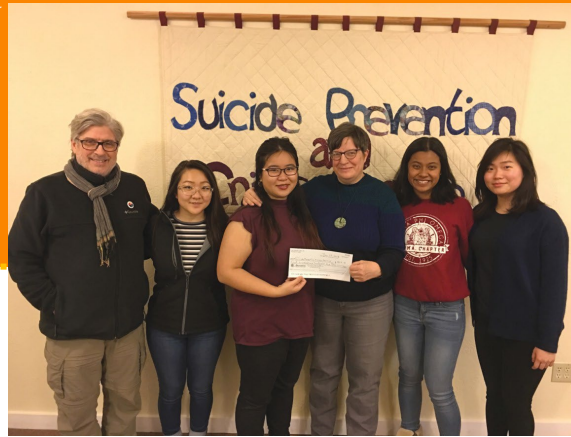
No Mas Lagrimas (No More Tears) is an organization that helps people with **clothing, food, and anything they need.**

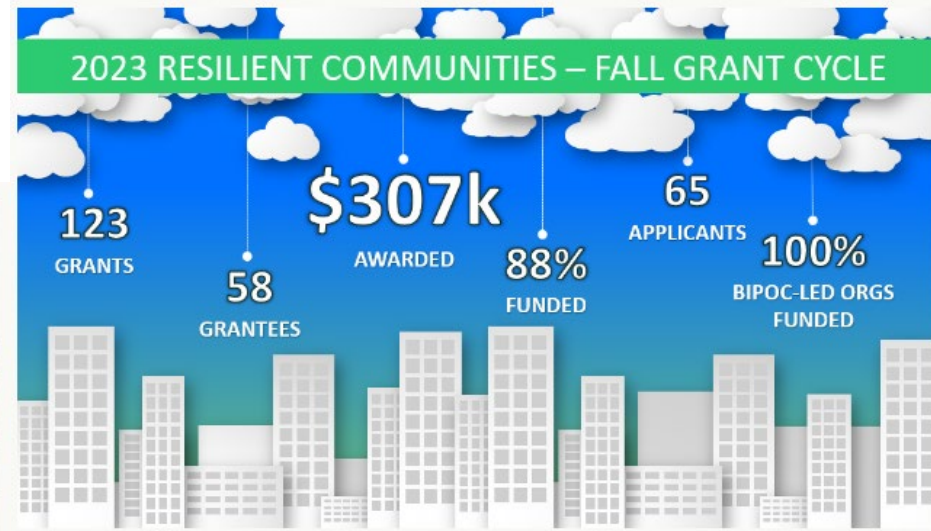

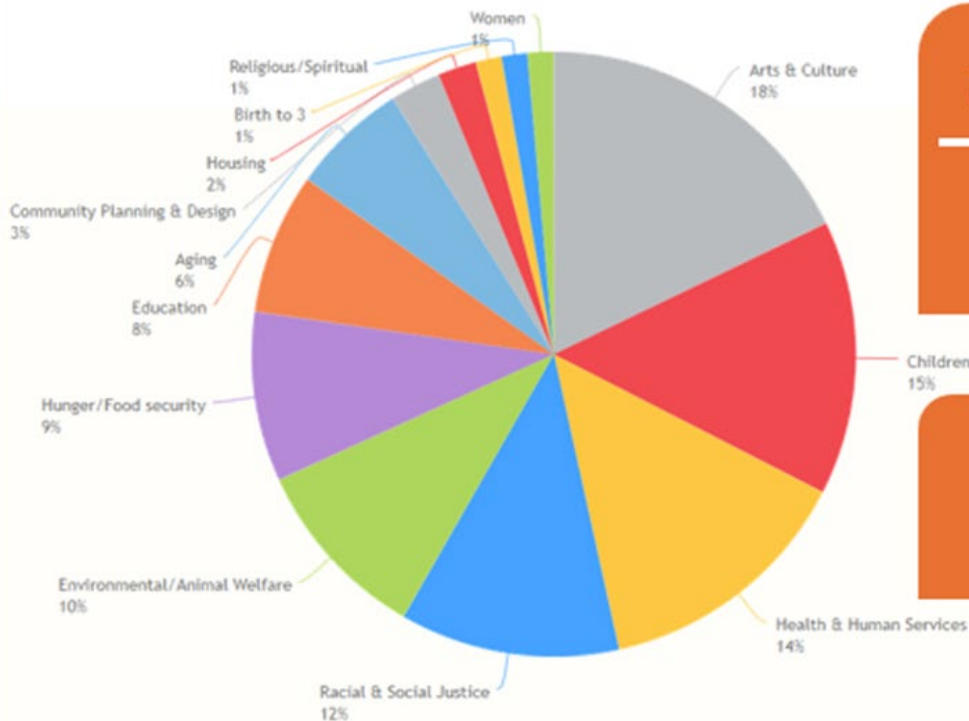
